Ar. UK. Bhoobalan, earned his B. Arch + M. Arch - Honor-Gold Medalist-University first (1987-1994, 7 years integrated degree program) from Tajik Technical University, Architecture & Urban Design- Faculty, Dushanbe, CIS, (USSR). The Soviet Union's crucible forged his talent. Eight years culminated in a 1994 Gold Medal thesis, "Temple of World Religions," which resonated in the Moscow International Architecture Competition, winning the first award and earning Aga Khan's first prize.

He started his career as Chief Architect at Bhoobal & Associates and was also Design Chief Architect in New York. The USSR ignited a dream – a new Indian metropolis, "New Chennai." His passionate advocacy, culminating in a powerful paper presentation at the 2003 GOPIO conference in New York, found fertile ground in Tamil Nadu, taking root and blossoming into reality.

Witnessing 1996's tapestry: Samathuvapuram, 130 threads of unity. Built on transcending caste and religion, this Soviet-inspired world record by Bhoobalans, implemented by then-CM M. Karunanidhi, wasn't just settlements, it was woven social harmony. 130 settlements, each consisting of 100 housings across Tamil Nadu.

Bhoobalan's thirst for impact extended beyond buildings. It sparked a passion for rainwater harvesting, which then Chief Minister Jayalalithaa implemented across Tamil Nadu, making it a pioneering state.

He was also a Professor at Linton University for UK program and was awarded the Best professor of architecture faculty. He has trained more than 2000 students worldwide to be architects and his journey continues as Principal.

Since there was no architecture college in the North East states and students had to travel far and wide in order to fulfill their dream of becoming an architect, Dona Foundation took it upon themselves to establish the First Architecture College in NE Region 'Guwahati College of Architecture' in 2006. Later on the department of Planning was added to the Institute and the college name was upgraded to 'Guwahati College of Architecture and Planning' (GCAP).

The college, promoted by Dona Foundation was inaugurated by Late Shri. Tarun Gogoi, Former Chief Minister of Assam on 26th January, 2006. The College offers a 5 year Bachelor Degree in Architecture and 2 year Master Degree in Planning (Urban & Regional Planning). The idea and perspective of Dona Foundation is to provide a platform to the creative talent of the region with the best industry exposure and placement to help students establish their careers.

With roots existing deep in providing quality education and with a view to provide students a platform to pursue a degree in Design as a fulfilling career option, 'Dona International Institute of Assam' (DIIA) was introduced in 2023.

The college has evolved over the years and all batches of students have passed out with a 100% placement track record. Eminent personalities are invited pan India as visiting faculty and Guest Lecturers periodically to guide and nurture the students in their studies and final year thesis.




GCAP has collaborated with various reputed architecture institutes for combined study tour to various Heritage sites.

was born in Bahari Satra, main Satra of Shree Shree Haridev, one of the four vaishnavite Gurus of Assam, and very interestingly took birth on the Janma-Tithi of Mahapurush Shree Shree Haridev, in the year 1918.

In the 19th Century the composite state of Assam till independence did not have any technical or medical college not to speak of university.

Shri. Sarbeswar Das overcame a lot of difficulties to become a civil engineer from a reputed and renowned institute at Lucknow.

As a true son of the soil he came back to Assam and joined Assam, PWD from where he retired after attaining superannuation in the year 1976.

This Knowledge Campus has been dedicated in the name of this illustrious son of Assam with the hope that quality education will be provided to the students who will serve the nation with a sense of integrity and devotion.

'Sarbeswar Das Knowledge Campus' is named after the Managing Trustee's father Architect Abani Das.

Located in the close vicinity of Lokpriya Gopinath Bordoloi International Airport at Azara, Guwahati this ten acre campus is surrounded by lush greenery amidst beautiful sceneries, the best Mother Nature could provide.

The ground floor of the building consists of huge Entrance lobby, all administrative departments, faculty departments, Library, Laboratories, Seminar Hall, etc. On the first floor there are studios, classrooms and on the second floor different activities as well as auditorium with capacity of 550 people.

The campus will also be equipped with short term and long term courses in various fields of Art, Architecture, Design, Life Science Workshops, Research, etc to enrich one's thirst for knowledge.



BENGALURU: India is on a path to rapid urbanization, but the country lacks adequate number of urban planners. According to the Unesco Global Education Monitoring report 2019 that was released on Tuesday, India requires 3 lakh urban town and country planners by 2031 to rejuvenate and develop its cities into smart ones. However, the country has only one urban planner per 4 lakh people.



In India, 21 universities offer postgraduate town planning programmes and only five offer them at the undergraduate level. As per the 2011 census, the country had only 4,500 qualified town and country planners, stated the report. And according to the report and experts, when it comes to urban planning education, nothing much has changed.

Scope for students studying Master of Planning (Urban & Regional Planning)

India Needs 3 Lakh Town Planners by 2031 : UNESCO Report

Prof N Sridharan, director, School of Planning and Architecture, Bhopal said: “The reason why urban planning education is lagging is due to lack of awareness about availability of any such course at the school and college level. Students are mostly told about mainstream professions. Urban planning education is different from architecture studies and has a lot more social, environmental and technical exposure.”

A review of institutions accredited by India's Institute of Town Planners showed many planning students lacked exposure to town and city problems. Further, they were unfamiliar with the functioning of urban development institutions and not up to date about urban development programmes.

But Professor Kala Seetharam Sridhar, head of department, centre for research in urban affairs, Institute for Social and Economic Change, Bengaluru, felt students are aware of present problems of urban and rural India. But the problem is at the recruitment level. Civic bodies, which are the biggest recruiters of urban town and country planners, do not have enough freedom. They have to depend on the urban development department for these requirements. If they are financially strong enough and can recruit town planners directly, the shortage can be addressed.”


LAB FACILITIES

MATERIAL LIBRARY: Consists of small scale models of sanitary fittings & fixtures and such other materials used in building constructions. There is also a workshop for carpentry demonstration and model making. Latest equipment for surveying are available for students.

LIBRARY



College has a well-equipped library consisting of a wide array of Reference books, Text books, Journals, CD's relevant to Architecture, Urban Design, Urban & Regional planning and all other fields like Scientology, General Knowledge, Design & many more. Well known Magazines and newspapers are subscribed to every year. A further addition to this collection is made every year. The library is managed by well qualified librarians.

The students are expected to make extensive use of Library to gain knowledge and for updated information. Internet facility is also available in the library.

The access to Library internet station shall be by fixing of time slot with prior request to the library staff.

Students shall handle the books with utmost care, not to spoil/ damage it. Students shall not write or make any marks inside/outside the book.


In case of damage to the books or internet media, students will be levied with fine as deemed appropriate by the college Authority; to cover the damage.

Deliberate attempt to damage the Library material shall lead to disciplinary action.

Students shall deposit at the library counter their Identity card, to access the library references. Identity card should be collected while retiring from library. Identity card will not be returned to the student if act of in-disciplined behavior or damage to books is noticed. Issue of books for personal study shall be strictly on the basis of library card, issued to a student.

Delay in returning the book may lead to invalidity of card and shall loose library facility.

In case of loss of library card it should be immediately brought to the notice of the office. Duplicate card may be allotted to the student on payment of administrative charges of Rs.200/-. Students must keep the decorum of the library.



WORKSHOPS

Workshops play an important role. Various workshops and exhibitions are organized at regular intervals in which students can represent their design innovations and showcase area specific skills.

The outcome of the workshops are showcased in exhibitions. Mentors, Senior Industry Professionals, and students of other institutes are invited for the same. Through such exposure and interaction the Institute aims to polish designing and presentation skills of students which are essential for their professional career.

Students will be taught how to navigate the rapidly changing landscape of interior design, keeping up to date with technological advancements and global design trends, and adapting their skills and knowledge accordingly. Graduates will be equipped with the confidence, creativity, and panache to become trend-setters in the industry, contributing to the evolution of interior design and pushing the boundaries of what is possible.

4 year Bachelor Degree with Honours/Research : The honours program typically involves advanced course work and a research project or thesis. Students are expected to demonstrate a high level of critical thinking, research, and communication skills. By the end of the fourth year, graduates will have an advanced understanding of interior design principles and practices, as well as the ability to undertake independent research and analysis. They should also be able to effectively communicate their design concepts and ideas to a variety of stakeholders, including clients, builders, and other professionals. POLICY OF THE INSTITUTE AGAINST RAGGING IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE DIRECTIONS OF HON. SUPREME COURT OF INDIA, UGC AND OTHER REGULATING BODIES.

The Institute takes most stringent view against any act of Ragging. All the existing and prospective students are strictly warned against indulging in any act and /abettment of ragging and their Guardians are advised to sensitize and advise their wards against the menace of ragging, which may lead to most severe punishment including the initiation of criminal proceedings. The students and their guardians are strongly advised to read the rulings of Hon. Supreme Court of India as regards to the same or may obtain the UGC Regulations on Curbing the Menace of Ragging in Higher Educational Institutions, 2009 guidelines against ragging from the website of UGC or respective regulating councils.

Ragging includes the following: Any conduct whether by words spoken or written or by an act which has the effect of harassing, teasing, treating or handling with rudeness any other student, indulging in rowdy or undisciplined activities which causes or is likely to cause annoyance, hardship or psychological harm or to raise fear or apprehension thereof in a fresher or a junior student or asking the students to do any act or perform something which such student will not in the ordinary course and which has the effect of causing or generating a sense of shame or embarrassment so as to adversely affect the physique or psyche of a fresher or a Junior student.

Punishable Ingredients of Ragging Including the following or any other act which is not included here but may be considered an act amounting to ragging by the competent authorities:

- Abetment to ragging
- Wrongful restraint
- Unnatural offences
- Criminal conspiracy to rag
- Wrongful confinement
- Extortion Criminal trespass
- Unlawful assembly and rioting while ragging
- Use of criminal force
- Offences against property
- Public nuisance created during ragging
- Assault as well as sexual offences or even
- Criminal intimidation
- Violation of decency and morals through ragging
- Injury to body causing hurt or grievous hurt

Attempts to commit any or all of the above mentioned offences against the victim(s)

Physical or psychological humiliation.

All other offences following from the definition of “Ragging”.

One indulging in ragging is likely to be punished appropriately which punishment may include expulsion from the institution, suspension from the institution or class for a limited period or fine with a public apology. The punishment may also take the shape of:

- (I) Withholding scholarships or other benefits,
- (ii) Debarring from representation in events,
- (iii) Withholding results, and
- (iv) Suspension or expulsion from hostel or mess, and the like.

A student, seeking hostel accommodation, shall deposit his/her hostel fees in total, to confirm admission to hostel for the term.


Student leaving the hostel in midway of the term, is not entitled for refund of hostel fees.





Ragging of any kind is strictly prohibited inside the college premises or outside. Students adhering to ragging will be immediately rusticated.


